RICHARD DOLAN is among the world's most prominent UFO researchers, and may be the world's pre-eminent historian of the subject. He is the author of two volumes of history, *UFOs and the National Security State*, widely recognized as "The Bible" of modern UFO studies, and providing a multitude of research avenues for current and future scholars. Best-selling author Whitley Strieber referred to them as "the best history ever written about UFOs," while Apollo 14 astronaut, Dr. Edgar Mitchell, described them as "masterful and important."

In his books and articles, Richard's main themes center around the destruction of our political liberties as a result of the UFO cover-up, the possible nature of the non-humans themselves, what their presence means for our civilization, why the cover-up will end within our lifetime, and what is likely to happen after that.

More recently, with the publication of *A.D. After Disclosure*, Richard (and co-author Bryce Zabel), offers a ground-breaking analysis of the future, a fearless and analytical "what if" scenario describing the deep impact that would be brought about by the end of UFO secrecy.

Richard's investigations have involved exploration of the U.S. and Canadian national archives, travel to conduct confidential interviews with some of the leading figures in the national security community, including four-star generals, retired admirals, highest-level CIA officers, famous scientists, men who have briefed U.S. Presidents, and individuals who have worked within the UFO cover-up.

Richard is a regular speaker at conferences around the world, and has appeared many times on the nationwide radio show *Coast-to-Coast AM*. He also delivered several presentations on UFOs at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C., receiving mention in *The Washington Post*.

Richard has also done a great deal of television work. In addition to numerous documentaries for independent filmmakers, he has appeared in more than 50 shows and documentaries for network broadcast in the U.S., Canada, U.K., and Europe.

Richard continues to research and write on UFOs and all related matters, offering fresh insights that speak to a world in the midst of social and technological transformation, and which push the field to redefine itself for the 21st century.

Richard Dolan was born in Brooklyn, New York. He studied at Alfred University in Western New York State, earning bachelor degrees in History and English Literature. During this time, he received a scholarship to study at Exeter College in Oxford University, where he earned a Certificate in Modern Political Theory. Richard was also a finalist for a Rhodes scholarship, and completed his graduate work in History at the University of Rochester. Prior to his interest in UFOs, he studied U.S. Cold War strategy, Soviet history and culture, and international diplomacy.
