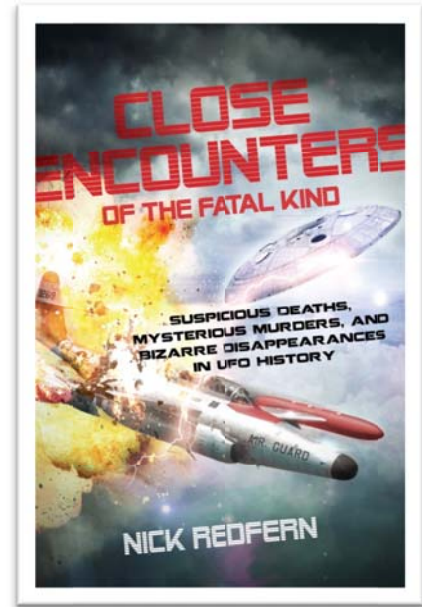


BOOK SUMMARY
