


# BOOK SUMMARY

## ***Sex, Sorcery, and Spirit***

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**T**he sexual act is possibly the most potent--and pleasurable--gateway to the primordial and the divine.

From the Tantric mysteries of Hinduism and Buddhism and the inner alchemy of Taoism, to the sacrament of the bridal chamber in Christianity--and, of course, the traditions of Western Magic and Witchcraft--sex pervades the highest and most secret teachings all over the world.

Jason begins with by relating two stories: one from the east and one from the west. The story from the east is the story of the Buddha first teaching Tantra to King Indrabhuti, and why he needed to teach a method of liberation that did not require withdrawing from the world. The story from the west is the tale of Poliphilo and his search his his love Polia told in the Hypnerotomachia Poliphili. Specifically how his search led him to three gates showing three methods of enlightenment: love of god, love of the world, or erotic love.. He connects these stories and makes a clear imperative for the practice of sex magic.

In Chapter 2 Jason dispels many of the false dangers associated with sex magic such as the concept that it is too shocking, or somehow blasphemous. He then moves on to discuss the actual dangers of sex magic such as its use in mind control groups, and the potential for increasing unstable emotions.

Chapter 3 covers the subtle body, and the various channels, chakras and seeds that are integral to sexual alchemy.

In Chapter 4 he teaches inner fire practice, which is the key to alchemical transformation, and the element that has been sorely missing from most western teachings on the subject.

Chapter 5 begins sex magic with some instruction on how to use masturbation to achieve the kind of orgasmic bliss needed for Sex Magic. There is also a brief discussion of pornography both in terms of its usefulness in auto-erotic magic and its dangers in developing unhealthy attachments.

Chapter 6 starts the chapter on Sex Magic with a partner, and focuses in on methods of invocation which allow the gods and spirits to experience bliss through us, and in turn diminish our own ego attachment.

Chapter 7 is a teaching on how to use the energetic maps and methods taught in chapters 3 and 4 during the sex act.

In Chapter 8 Jason discusses the use of sexual fluids in magic and how they can be consumed as a sacrament or used to annoint talismans. This is the alchemists elixir of life.

Chapter 9 is a rare teaching on sexual methods for creating spirit beings that can act as familiars and helpers.

Chapter 10 is a discussion of sexual congress between Humans and spirits - be it angels, demons, elves, or even at least in one case, the holy spirit of God.

Chapter 11 covers BDSM and Fetish practices and how they can be integrated into Sexual Magic and Alchemy.

Chapter 12 is a small grimoire of rituals that serve as examples of how the teachings in this book can be put to use.
