

LARRY FLAXMAN



Larry Flaxman has been actively involved in paranormal research and field investigation for over ten years. He blends his technical, scientific, and investigative backgrounds together for scientific, objective explanations regarding a variety of anomalous phenomena. Flaxman is the president and senior researcher of ARPAST, the Arkansas Paranormal and Anomalous Studies Team, which he founded in February 2007.

ARPAST is one of the nation's largest and most active paranormal research organizations dedicated to using stringent scientific methodology. Widely respected for his expertise on the proper use of equipment and techniques for conducting a solid investigation, Flaxman also serves as technical advisor to paranormal research groups around the country.

Flaxman published several articles regarding science and the paranormal and is a regular columnist for The Paranormal Awareness Society Newsletter. Currently, he is the co-author (with Marie D. Jones) of the upcoming book *The Resonance Key: Exploring the Links Between Vibration, Consciousness and the Zero Point Grid* for New Page Books. He is also co-creator of ParaExplorers.com, which is devoted to the exploration of ancient and modern unknown mysteries.

In addition, Flaxman is co-creator of the new ParaTracker software program used for documenting data from paranormal investigations. His own ARPAST online research database system, SOCIUS, is considered one of the most comprehensive in the field. His enthusiasm for education and training in the paranormal field has also garnered many requests for special events and seminars, including popular charity investigations at haunted locations across the South and lectures on paranormal awareness.

Flaxman has been featured in newspapers, magazines and online publications and has been interviewed on many radio and television programs.

Flaxman works in law enforcement / information technology, is married and lives in Little Rock, Arkansas.
