SPIRITUAL TEACHER RELEASES INTERPLANETARY COMMUNIQUÉ WARNING OF EXTRATERRESTRIAL "INTERVENTION"

According to Summers, the Allies, stationed at a hidden location within our solar system to observe and report on extraterrestrial activities on and around Earth, charge that our intruding visitors are in reality resource explorers and trade collectives who are seeking to gain competitive, economic and psychological advantage in our emerging world.
