
UFOS & ALIENS

CHAPTER SUMMARY



The article is based on an interview Hanks had with a former Army security officer named "Steven," a little over a year ago. While stationed on Johnston Atoll in 1988, he and several hundred witnesses observed a gigantic circular UFO that appeared and hovered directly overhead just before dawn on a morning in July of that year. Then, as the sun broke over the horizon, the gigantic UFO simply vanished. Steven suspects that what he and the others on the island (including one retired two-star general) witnessed was an extraterrestrial craft experiencing some kind of malfunction that allowed them to see it hovering over

them for a short period of time. This remains one of the top three most incredible UFO stories Hanks has ever been told.

Hanks located other individuals who were stationed on the island at the time for corroborative testimony, and interviewed stealth aircraft experts about the possibility that an advanced cloaking technology was seen in-use. Save a few scant reports that deal with crashed UFOs like Roswell, we are seldom given any indication that these aircraft, whatever they are, may have their various flaws, too... until now.

His interest in the region and its many mysteries, as well as his ever-evolving methods of inquiry pertaining to the UFO phenomenon at large, remains underway.

Hanks has been featured as a guest on many television and radio programs, including History Channel's *Guts and Bolts*, Travel Channel's *Weird Travels*, *CNN Radio*, and *The Jeff Rense Program*.
