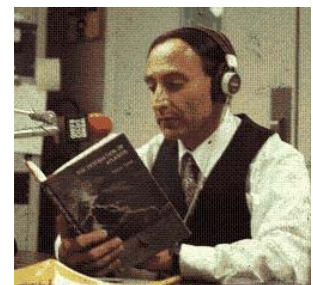


MARIE D. JONES
